WHEREAS, in 2002, the former Redevelopment Agency ("Agency"), the City of Long Beach, and Team Lofts, LLC entered into a three-party Disposition and Development Agreement ("DDA"), as part of the 4th Street Lofts development project; and

WHEREAS, the Agency also entered into a Parking Easement Agreement to effectuate the development project; and

WHEREAS, the DDA provided for the conveyance of City-owned land to the Agency for development of 40 public parking spaces in conjunction with the condominium project; and

WHEREAS, the DDA grants an easement to the City for the 40 parking spaces as well as an easement to the Agency for eight additional parking spaces; these obligations are contained within the Parking Easement Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on June 23 and July 27, 2015, the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Long Beach ("Successor Agency") and the Oversight Board of the City of Long Beach as the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Long Beach ("Oversight Board"), amended the Long Range Property Management Plan to transfer the Successor Agency's parking spaces to the City as a

Government Use for continued use as parking; and

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2015, the Department of Finance approved the amendment to the Long Range Property Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, with the transfer of these parking spaces, the Successor Agency does not have any other purpose to be a party to the DDA or any other agreement related to the project; and

WHEREAS, this matter was approved by the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Long Beach on January 26, 2016;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Oversight Board of the City of Long Beach as the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. Approve the decision of the Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Long Beach to remove the Successor Agency as a responsible party to any and all agreements related to the 4th Street Lofts development project at 834 East Fourth Street and 355 Alamitos Avenue, including the Disposition and Development Agreement, dated January 10, 2002.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Oversight Board, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
