## ORDINANCE NO. ORD-13-0010

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AMENDING THE LONG BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 10.64.010 RELATING TO TRAFFIC DIRECTION

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 10.64.010 of the Long Beach Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

10.64.010 Traffic direction.

No person shall fail or refuse to comply with any lawful order of a Police

Officer, Fire Department official or Disaster Service Worker approved by the Chief
of Police, who is directing traffic.

Section 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the City Council and cause it to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the City of Long Beach, and it shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day after it is approved by the Mayor.
