A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH ADOPTING AN APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR THE CITY OF LONG BEACH FOR THE 2007-2008 FISCAL YEAR PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XIII(B) OF THE CALIFORNIA CONSTITUTION

WHEREAS, Article XIII(B) of the California Constitution provides for an annual appropriations limit for state and local governments beginning with the 1980-81 fiscal year, based on 1978-79 appropriations, as adjusted for specified annual changes in population and inflation; and

WHEREAS, Section 7910 of the Government Code also provides that 15 days prior to such meeting, documentation used in the determination of the appropriations limit shall be available to the public; and that each year the City Council shall, by resolution, establish the appropriations limit for the City of Long Beach for the following fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 111 subsequently amended Article III(B) of the
California Constitution to provide for certain revisions in the population and inflation
factors used in the calculation of the appropriations limit and to provide for a recalculation
of the appropriation limit date for the years 1987-88 through 1990-91; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 111 provided that one factor that may be used in
the calculation of the appropriations limit is the increase in local non-residential assessed
value due to new construction; and

WHEREAS, the documentation which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A" was used in the determination of the appropriations limit for the 27 2007-2008 fiscal year, and has been available for public inspection in the office of the 28 City Clerk since August 27, 2007;
