

SECOND AMENDMENT TO BILL REVIEW SERVICING AGREEMENT NO. 34570

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO BILL REVIEW SERVICING AGREEMENT NO. 34570 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of April 23, 2020 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on March 7, 2017, by and between MEDATA, INC., a California corporation ("Medata"), with principal offices at 5 Peters Canyon Road, #250, Irvine, California 92606, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, City and Medata (the "Parties") entered into Agreement No. 34570 (the "Agreement") whereby Medata agreed to provide medical billing review services and information utilizing proprietary software and expertise to City; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a First Amendment to the Agreement to extend the term to April 30, 2020 and update the Compensation attached as Exhibit "B" to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to extend the term one (1) additional one-year term and again update the Compensation attached as Exhibit "B" to the Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions herein contained, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Section 1 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

"1. EFFECTIVE DATE AND TERM. This Agreement shall begin on May 1, 2017, and shall end on April 30, 2021 (both days inclusive), unless terminated earlier in accordance with Section 12. This Agreement may be extended for one (1) additional one-year period, at the discretion of the City Manager."

2. The Compensation contained in Exhibit "B-1" attached hereto and incorporated herein hereby replaces and supersedes the Compensation attached to the Agreement as Exhibit "B" and the First Amendment.

3. Except as expressly modified herein, all of the terms and conditions contained in Agreement No. 34570 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force

- Any un-listed procedure codes (CPT 99199) when billed in conjunction with injection procedures
- Any anesthesia line charge for CPT code range 00100 – 09999 with a modifier of P3, P4, or P5
- Any charges for somatosensory testing CPT code range 95925 – 95927
- Any nerve conduction study line charge CPT code range 95900 – 95935 in which charges exceed \$500.00
- All higher-level office visits or consultations in which level of service is adjusted
