3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH PUBLIC
6 CORPORATION FOR THE ARTS OF THE CITY OF LONG
7 BEACH DBA ARTS COUNCIL FOR LONG BEACH,
8 WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, TO FUND LONG
9 BEACH RECOVERY ACT GRANT PROGRAMS, IN A
10 TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$681,000, FOR A
11 PERIOD OF TWO YEARS, WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW
12 FOR ONE ADDITIONAL ONE-YEAR PERIOD, AT THE
13 DISCRETION OF THE CITY MANAGER

15 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1801, permits the
16 City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise, without
17 advertising for bids for services when authorized by resolution; and

18 WHEREAS, on March 16, 2021, the City Council of the City of Long Beach
19 adopted the Long Beach Recovery Act (LB Recovery Act), a COVID-19 recovery program
20 to support City programming in three main categories: Healthy and Safe Communities,
21 Economic Recovery, and Securing our City's Future; and

22 WHEREAS, as part of the Economic Recovery category of the LB Recovery
23 Act, the City has a need for a vendor to implement and administer the City's LB Recovery
24 Act arts support grant programs; and

25 WHEREAS, the Public Corporation for the Arts of the City of Long Beach Inc.
26 dba Arts Council for Long Beach (Arts LB) is the only organization with the necessary
27 experience, qualifications, and institutional knowledge to successfully administer the City's
28 arts support grant program; and

1 WHEREAS, Arts LB acts as a clearinghouse for all arts, culture and historical
2 organizations within the City and has a long-standing contractual relationship with the City
3 to manage City-funded arts programs, including programming for public art and grant
4 programs; and

5 WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising
6 for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and unnecessary expenditure
7 of public funds;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
9 follows:

10 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
11 herein;

12 Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
13 with Arts LB, without advertising for bids, to fund LB Recovery Act grant programs in a total
14 amount not to exceed Six Hundred Eighty-One Thousand Dollars (\$681,000) for a period
15 of two (2) years, with option to renew for one (1) additional one-year period, at the discretion
16 of the City Manager.

17 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
18 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.

19 I hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the City Council
20 of the City of Long Beach at its meeting of July 12, 2022 by the

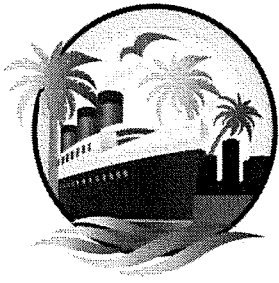
