## SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 35443

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 35443 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of March 2, 2022 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on November 19, 2019, by and between TRAUMA INTERVENTION PROGRAMS, INC., a California corporation, with a place of business at, 1420 Phillips Street, Vista, CA, 92083, hereinafter referred to as "TIP" and/or "Contractor", and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, City requires specialized services requiring unique skills to be performed in connection with emotional and practical support services to victims of traumatic events and their families; and

WHEREAS, City and Contractor (the "Parties") entered into Agreement No. 35443 (the "Contract") whereby Contractor agreed to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into a First Amendment to amend the terms of the contract; and

WHEREAS the parties currently desire to extend the term for an additional one-year period;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions herein contained, the Parties agree as follows:

- Section 8 of the Agreement No. 35443 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- "8. TERM. Unless sooner terminated as provided for herein, this Agreement shall end at 11:59 p.m. on January 31, 2023, unless sooner terminated as provided herein. The City shall have the option to extend the term annually at the discretion of the City Manager."
- 2. Except as expressly modified herein, all of the terms and conditions contained in Agreement No. 35443 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force
