RESOLUTION NO. RES-06-0064

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE SPOUSAL ABUSER PROSECUTION **PROGRAM** (SAPP) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY CONTRACTS AND DOCUMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the Long Beach City Prosecutor has implemented a specialized unit for the prosecution of misdemeanor domestic violence crimes, and;

WHEREAS, the California Department of Justice offers grants of State supplemental funds in the sum of Forty Three Thousand Five Hundred and Fifty-Seven Dollars (\$43,557) for such specialized prosecution programs through the Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program known as the "SAP" Program, and;

WHEREAS, the Long Beach City Prosecutor desires such grant funds in order to enhance the successful prosecution of misdemeanor spouse abuse, elder abuse and child abuse crimes in the City of Long Beach, and;

WHEREAS, the State grant for SAPP funds requires the City of Long Beach to commit city matching funds in an amount not to exceed Eight Thousand Seven Hundred and Twelve Dollars (\$8,712.00);

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City's participation in the SAPP Program is hereby approved. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take such steps as may be necessary to submit a SAP Program grant application to the California Department of Justice, to

execute all grant application documents and or agreements, to accept on behalf of the City of Long Beach a SAPP grant in the approximate amount of Forty Three Thousand Five Hundred and Fifty-Seven Dollars (\$43,557), and make an expenditure of City funds in an amount not to exceed Eight Thousand Seven Hundred and Twelve Dollars (\$8,712.00) to match the SAPP grant funds received. No portion of the SAPP grant funds shall be used to supplant local expenditures.

Section 2. It is agreed that any liability arising out of the performance of the above-mentioned grant award agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and the Department of Justice disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

Section 3. The Long Beach City Prosecutor Department's budget shall be amended to reflect the receipt and expenditure of the SAP Program grant funds.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
