WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Ridgefield Park has a contract for the purchase of aerial ladder trucks through its Contract dated as of December 17, 2003 ("Ridgefield Park Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Ridgefield Park Contract will facilitate acquisition of these trucks as well as provide considerable costs benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the Ridgefield Park Contract considerably more funds would be required; and

WHEREAS, Resolution C-28461 was adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting held on October 5, 2004 authorizing the City Manager to enter into an agreement to purchase one (1) aerial ladder truck with the option to amend the agreement for the purchase of additional vehicles while the original vehicle is still under warranty; and

WHEREAS, the City entered into Agreement No. 29136 with Seagrave Fire
