


EXHIBIT A

CITY COUNCIL FINDINGS

VACATION OF PORTIONS OF FOURTH STREET AND ELM AVENUE ADJACENT TO 395 EAST FOURTH STREET - Reference Sketch No. 946V

1. The subject right-of-way is unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

This finding is based upon the following subfindings:

- a) Those findings stated in the City Manager's letter submitted for the November 15, 2005, City Council meeting regarding the resolution of intention to vacate the subject right-of-way, adopted as Resolution No. RES-05-0133.
- b) The rights-of-way would not be useful for exclusive bikeway purposes.
- 2. The vacation of said rights-of-way will not have a significantly adverse environmental effect.

This finding is based upon the following subfindings:

- a) The right-of-way is not and will not be needed for public use.
- c) In conformance with the California Environmental Quality Act, an Environmental Impact Report was completed for this project, filed as report number 20000011097.
