SECOND AMENDMENT TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION PHARMACY BENEFITS ADMINISTRATION AGREEMENT NO. 35140

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION PHARMACY BENEFITS ADMINISTRATION AGREEMENT NO. 35140 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of November 30, 2021, for reference purposes only, by and between TMESYS LLC, ("Tmesys") a Florida limited liability company, as successor-in-interest to PHARMACEUTICAL TECHNOLOGIES, INC., D/B/A CASTIARX, a Nebraska corporation ("PTI"), and the City of Long Beach, a California municipal corporation ("City"). Tmesys and the City are collectively referred to as the "Parties".

WHEREAS, City and PTI (the "Parties") entered into Agreement No. 35140 (the "Agreement") for pharmacy benefits management (PBM) services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a First Amendment to the Agreement to extend the term to December 31, 2021, reflect the name change and attach a new Network Pharmacy Reimbursement exhibit; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to extend the term one (1) additional one-year period;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions herein contained, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 5.01 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:
- "5.01 <u>Term and Renewal</u>. This Agreement shall commence on January 1, 2019, and shall end on December 31, 2022 (both days inclusive), unless terminated earlier in accordance with Section 5.02, Section 5.03, Section 5.04, and Section 5.05. This Agreement may be extended for one (1) additional one-year period, at the discretion of the City Manager."
- Except as expressly modified herein, all the terms and conditions contained in Agreement No. 35140 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
