

RESOLUTION NO. RES-19-0095

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR GRANT FUNDS FOR THE GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT PROGRAM, FOR THE LONG BEACH MUNICIPAL URBAN STORMWATER TREATMENT RECYCLE FACILITY

WHEREAS, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have provided funds for the program shown above; and

WHEREAS, the California Natural Resources Agency has been delegated the responsibility for the administration of this grant program, establishing necessary procedures; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the California Natural Resources Agency require a resolution certifying the approval of application(s) by the City Council of the City of Long Beach before submission of said application(s) to the State; and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach, if selected, will enter into a contract with the State of California to carry out the below-mentioned Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Long Beach ("City Council") hereby approves the filing of a grant application for Prop. 68 funds for the Long Beach Municipal Urban Stormwater Treatment Recycle Facility Project (the "Project").

Section 2. The City Council hereby certifies that the City of Long Beach ("City") understands the assurances and certification in the application.

Section 3. The City Council hereby certifies that the City will have

1 sufficient funds to operate and maintain the Project consistent with the land tenure
2 requirements.

3 Section 4. The City Council certifies that the City will comply with all
4 provisions of Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code.

5 Section 5. The City Council certifies that the Project will comply with any
6 laws and regulations including, but not limited to, the California Environmental Quality Act
7 (CEQA), legal requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, and disabled
8 access laws, and that prior to commencement of construction all applicable permits will
9 have been obtained.

10 Section 6. The City Council certifies that the City will work towards the
11 State Planning Priorities intended to promote equity, strengthen the economy, protect the
12 environment, and promote public health and safety as included in Government Code
13 Section 65041.1

14 Section 7. The City Council appoints the City Manager, or designee, as
15 agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not
16 limited to applications, agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be
17 necessary for the completion of the Project.

18 Section 8. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
19 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
