AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH ADDING SECTION 1.21.080 TO THE
LONG BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO BALLOT
FORMAT

The City Council of the City of Long Beach hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 1.21.080 is hereby added to Chapter 1.21 of the Long
Beach Municipal Code to read as follows:

1.21.080 Ballot format.

Notwithstanding the provisions of the California Elections Code, the
City Clerk shall determine the format of ballots used in all elections held
pursuant to Article XIX and Section 2206 of the Charter of the City of Long
Beach, provided that such ballot format is consistent with all other
applicable regulations pertaining thereto.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the
City Council and cause it to be posted in three conspicuous places in the City of Long
Beach, and it shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the Mayor.
