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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT AND ANY  
6 AMENDMENTS THERETO WITH BRÜEL & KJAER EMS  
7 INC. WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR BIDS FOR THE  
8 MAINTENANCE, UPGRADE AND SUPPORT OF THE LONG  
9 BEACH AIRPORT NOISE AND OPERATIONS  
10 MONITORING SYSTEM (ANOMS) IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT  
11 NOT TO EXCEED \$297,851 FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR  
12 WITH THE OPTION TO RENEW FOR FOUR ADDITIONAL  
13 ONE-YEAR PERIODS, PLUS A ONE-TIME EQUIPMENT  
14 UPGRADE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$340,425  
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16 WHEREAS, the Long Beach Airport utilizes the Airport Noise and Operations  
17 Monitoring System ("ANOMS") to enforce the City's noise compatibility ordinance; and

18 WHEREAS, the City's noise ordinance (LBMC Chapter 16.43) is recognized  
19 as one of the strictest in the country and the administration of the ordinance requires  
20 specialized, unique and custom data processing and reporting programs; and

21 WHEREAS, a competitive bid process was conducted in 1991 for an  
22 ANOMS, which resulted in an award to Lochard Corporation, predecessor in interest to  
23 Bruel & Kjaer EMS Inc.; and

24 WHEREAS, the installation of the ANOMS system enabled airport staff to  
25 ensure flight data accuracy and completeness for monitoring and compiling the annual  
26 noise analysis budget, Los Angeles County Quarterly reporting, complaint entry  
27 investigations, community reports, tenant and user fly-quiet procedures and reports for  
28 noise violation enforcement; and

1           WHEREAS, due to the unique nature and enforcement requirements of  
2 LBMC 16.43, the ANOMS installation includes customized data collection and processing  
3 algorithms specific to the Long Beach Airport; and

4           WHEREAS, the associated hardware/software combination was designed by  
5 Bruel & Kjaer EMS Inc. and is used solely with Bruel & Kjaer EMS Inc. solutions; and

6           WHEREAS, Bruel & Kjaer EMS Inc. is the only company capable of providing  
7 technical support and services needed for maintaining, upgrading and supporting the  
8 ANOMS system; and

9           WHEREAS, no useful purpose would be served by advertising for bids and  
10 to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary expenditure of public  
11 funds because Bruel & Kjaer EMS Inc. is the only corporation, firm or individual that could  
12 or would bid for the maintenance, upgrade and support of the Airport Noise and Operations  
13 Monitoring System;

14           NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as  
15 follows:

16           Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter a contract,  
17 without advertising for bids, with Bruel & Kjaer EMS Inc. for the maintenance, upgrade and  
18 support of the Airport Noise and Operations Monitoring System (ANOMS) for a period of  
19 one (1) year with the option to extend for two (2) additional one-year periods in an annual  
20 amount not to exceed Two Hundred Forty-Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-One  
21 Dollars (\$247,851). Plus, authorize a one-time equipment upgrade in the amount of Three  
22 Hundred Forty Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$340,425), an annual  
23 contingency in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) for additional service, and  
24 a 3.5 percent annual CPI increase.. If the sole source status of Bruel & Kjaer EMS Inc.  
25 changes, City shall publicly bid instead of extending the contract.

26           Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption  
27 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
