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RESOLUTION NO. RES-23-0126

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH TEKNION, LLC, OF MOUNT LAUREL, NEW JERSEY TO FURNISH AND DELIVER FURNITURE SOLUTIONS WITH RELATED ACCESSORIES AND SERVICES ON AN AS-NEEDED BASIS ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO SOURCEWELL THROUGH THEIR CONTRACT WITH TEKNION, LLC IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,400,000, INCLUSIVE OF A 20 PERCENT CONTINGENCY, UNTIL THE SOURCEWELL CONTRACT EXPIRES ON FEBRUARY 18, 2024, WITH THE RENEW FOR OPTION TO AS LONG AS THE SOURCEWELL CONTRACT IS IN EFFECT, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, City Council approval is requested to enter into a contract with Teknion, LLC ("Teknion") for the furnishing and delivering of furniture solutions with related accessories and services on an as-needed basis; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has initiated the largest departmentwide restructuring which included the creation of the New Office of Constitutional policing in Fiscal Year (FY) 21, the new Community Services Bureau and Executive Communications

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Division in FY 23, and has proposed the creation of a Center for Crime Information Analysis in FY 24, among other changes; and

WHEREAS, These new operations require reconfiguring sections of the Public Safety Building and the Police Department area at 3205 Lakewood Blvd. to accommodate the new employee working groups; and

WHEREAS, this project aims to not only redesign office layouts to match the new organizational structure, but to provide ergonomic furnishings that will help reduce employee injury and fatigue; and

WHEREAS, major renovations have not been completed to the professional workspaces in the Public Safety Building for over twenty years and Teknion's product line will be used to replace over two hundred employee cubicles; and

WHEREAS, the Finance and Facilities Division of the Police Department researched procurement options for furniture solutions with related accessories and services and discovered other agencies had completed an open, fair, transparent, and competitive procurement process; and

WHEREAS, Teknion was selected based on their competitive pricing, service level, and breadth of product offerings; and

WHEREAS, Teknion LLC is an international designer and manufacturer of office systems and related products, including storage and filing, seating, case goods, tables and ergonomic furniture and have been in business for over 36 years; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to furnish and deliver furniture solutions with related accessories and services on an as-needed basis; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell has a Contract for the purchase of these furniture solutions with related accessories and services, Contract No. 121919-TKN ("Sourcewell Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the Sourcewell Contract will facilitate the City's ability to purchase as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and WHEREAS, if the City had to utilize a formal bid process rather than

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participate in the Sourcewell Contract considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter Section 2. into an agreement with Teknion, LLC of Mount Laurel, New Jersey for the furnishing and delivering of furniture solutions with related accessories and services on an as-needed basis, of the same type and kind identified in the Sourcewell Contract except as modified by mutual agreement of the City and Teknion, LLC, and the purchase by the City shall be on the same terms and conditions afforded to Sourcewell in a total aggregate amount not to exceed Two Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,400,000) inclusive of a 20 percent contingency, until the Sourcewell contract expires on February 18, 2024, with the option to renew for as long as the Sourcewell contract is in effect, at the discretion of the City Manager.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
