3 RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH APPROVING THE APPLICATION  
5 FOR GRANT FUNDS FOR THE URBAN GREENING  
6 GRANT PROGRAM, UNDER THE SAFE DRINKING  
7 WATER, WATER QUALITY AND SUPPLY, FLOOD  
8 CONTROL, RIVER AND COASTAL PROTECTION BOND  
9 ACT OF 2006 (PROPOSITION 84) FOR THE DEFOREST  
10 WETLANDS PROJECT

12 WHEREAS, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have  
13 provided funds for the program shown above; and

14 WHEREAS, the Strategic Growth Council has been delegated the  
15 responsibility for the administration of this grant program; establishing necessary  
16 procedures; and

17 WHEREAS, said procedures established by the Strategic Growth Council  
18 require a resolution certifying the approval of Application(s) by the Applicants' governing  
19 board before submission of said Application(s) to the State; and

20 WHEREAS, the Applicant, if selected, will enter into an Agreement with the  
21 State of California to carry out the Project;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Long Beach City Council  
23 hereby:

24 Section 1. Approves the filing of an Application for the DeForest Wetlands  
25 Project; and

26 Section 2. Certifies that Applicant understands the assurances and  
27 certification in the Application; and

28 Section 3. Certifies that Applicant or the title holder will have sufficient

1 funds to operate and maintain the Project(s) consistent with the land tenure requirements;  
2 or will secure the resources to do so; and

3 Section 4. Certifies that it will comply with all provisions of Section 1771.8  
4 of the California Labor Code regarding payment of prevailing wages on Projects awarded  
5 Proposition 84 Funds; and

6 Section 5. If applicable, certifies that the Project will comply with any laws  
7 and regulations including, but not limited to, the California Environmental Quality Act  
8 (CEQA), legal requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, disabled access  
9 laws, and that prior to commencement of construction, all applicable permits will have  
10 been obtained; and

11 Section 6. Certifies that applicant will work towards the Governor's State  
12 Planning Priorities intended to promote equity, strengthen the economy, protect the  
13 environment, and promote public health and safety as included in Government Code  
14 Section 65041.1; and

15 Section 7. Appoints the City Manager, or designee, as agent to conduct all  
16 negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to Applications,  
17 Agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of  
18 the aforementioned project(s).
