## FIFTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 35632

THIS FIFTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 35632 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of February 7, 2022 for reference purposes only, pursuant to Chapters 2.69 and 2.85 of the Long Beach Municipal Code, by and between KJP II ENTERPRISES, LLC, DBA DAYS INN, a California limited liability corporation, hereinafter called "OWNER", with a place of business at 1500 E Pacific Coast Highway, Long Beach, California, 90806, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, City requires specialized services requiring unique skills to be performed in connection with Emergency Occupancy related to COVID-19, and is directly related to that emergency and necessary for the preservation of public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, the scope and magnitude of the response necessary to proactively slow the spread of, and combat, COVID-19 in the City is beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the City; and

WHEREAS, City and Owner (the "Parties") entered into Agreement No. 35632 (the "Agreement") whereby Owner agreed to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a First Amendment to extend the term of the Agreement for an additional six-month period; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Second Amendment extend the term of the Agreement due to additional funding provided by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Third Amendment to extend the term of the Agreement for an additional six-month period due to another round of additional funding provided by FEMA; and

WHEREAS, the Parties to entered into a Fourth Amendment to increase the rate per room by Six Dollars (\$6), for a total of One Hundred and Twenty-Six Dollars (\$126.00) per room; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to extend the term of the Agreement for an additional three-month period; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 2.85 of the Long Beach Municipal Code, the City Manager and Purchasing Agent have the authority to approve purchases, rentals, or leases of goods or services related to a proclaimed emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions herein contained, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 2. of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:
- "2. <u>TERM</u> The term of this Agreement shall commence on October 1, 2020, and shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on September 30, 2022."
- Except as expressly modified herein, all of the terms and conditions contained in Agreement No. 35632 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
