A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT  
AGENCY OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA,  
ADOPTING A HOUSING REPLACEMENT PLAN FOR THE  
WASHINGTON SCHOOL FOCUS AREA PROJECT

Whereas, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Long Beach, California (“Agency”), is negotiating the redevelopment of property bounded by Pacific Coast Highway to the north, Anaheim Boulevard to the south, Long Beach Boulevard to the east, and Magnolia Avenue to the west (the “Washington School Focus Area Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Washington School Focus Area Project will result in displacement of existing housing units; and

WHEREAS, California Health and Safety Code Section 33413.5 requires that the Agency adopt a housing replacement plan for the Washington School Focus Area Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Long Beach, California, resolves as follows:

The Agency hereby adopts the Replacement Housing Plan for the Washington School Focus Area Project, which is attached as Exhibit “A” to this resolution.
