- (C) 1. Provide all labor, materials and equipment to install a new traffic signal at the intersection Regway Avenue and Willow Street per construction drawing dated January 4, 2012, as directed by the Project Engineer,
- Provide all labor, materials and equipment to install additional American with Disabilities Act (ADA) ramps at the intersection of Regway Avenue and Willow Street per construction drawing dated January 4, 2012 at the negotiated unit cost of \$7,800.00 each (2/EA @ \$7,800.00/EA), as directed by the Project Engineer,
- Provide all labor, materials and equipment to (C) 3. make traffic signal modifications to the intersection of 3rd Street and the Promenade per cost quote dated October 22, 2012, as directed by the Project Engineer,

In accordance with Section 3-3, Extra Work, of the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction 2009 Edition, you are authorized to do the following:

(C) 4. Provide all labor, materials and equipment to pothole unforeseen utilities including structural backfill of the trench at the intersection of Regway Avenue and Willow Street, not depicted on the construction drawings, as directed by the Project Engineer,
