3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH CARDINAL
6 POINT CAPTAINS, INC. WITHOUT ADVERTISING FOR
7 BIDS FOR THE MARITIME MOBILE COMMUNICATION
8 AND COMMAND PLATFORM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
9 EXCEED \$486,064.

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11 WHEREAS, the Long Beach Police Department (LBPD) Port Police Division
12 (PPD) is responsible for providing law enforcement and homeland security services to the
13 Port of Long Beach; and

14 WHEREAS, PPD relies on mobile communication and command platforms
15 as part of its Incident Command Structure, which are used during critical emergency
16 incidents as well as homeland security efforts; and

17 WHEREAS, this equipment provides PPD with the ability to collect and
18 disseminate operational data from maritime operation sites where cell phone and internet
19 access are non-existent; and

20 WHEREAS, the system also supports data transmission from underwater
21 operations and allows supervising law enforcement personnel located on the shore to
22 make critical decisions during critical maritime incidents; and

23 WHEREAS, Cardinal Point Captains is the sole manufacturer of the Triton
24 Mobile Communications and Command Platform and is the only authorized supplier and
25 service provider for this product; and

26 WHEREAS, as a result, no useful purpose would be served by advertising
27 for bids and to do so would constitute an idle and useless act and an unnecessary
28 expenditure of public funds;

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NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter a contract with CARDINAL POINT CAPTAINS, INC. for furnishing a Triton Mobile Command and Communication Platform in an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Sixty-Four Dollars (\$486,064).


Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
