Mr. Parkin and staff,

I am a resident who lives approximately 100 feet behind Legend's sports bar. My neighbors and I found out almost by accident that the hearing for their entertainment permit is being heard today. We were not notified of today's rescheduled hearing despite many of us filing disagreement notices with the ABC.

The permit application states that '*residents within 300 feet were notified*'. I have talked to at least a half dozen neighbors and only one received that notice. This has put us and our protest at significant disadvantage.

When we consider the number of disturbances that occur at Legend's without an entertainment permit, we are horrified that the Police and Fire departments are supporting this in light of the number of call and visitations by their forces.

At least three of us reached out to our Councilperson, Suzie Price, and none got a response. We all have a very justified feeling that we are being stonewalled and are not at all happy about the entire process.

**We would like to have our voices heard and ask that the hearing be postponed again and that ALL residents within 300 feet are actually notified BEFORE the new hearing date.**

We are meeting and mobilizing against this approval as it will represent a significant disturbance to our right to expect a peaceful environment.
