WHEREAS the City is an Eligible Applicant under the TOD Program and wishes to apply for a TOD Program Grant in an amount not to exceed \$3,350,000 ("TOD Grant") to develop infrastructure in support of affordable housing ("TOD Project") under the above described NOFA;

Section 2. The City is hereby authorized and directed to act in connection with the Department's TOD Grant pursuant to the above mentioned NOFA.

In connection with the City's TOD Grant, the City is authorized and directed to enter into, execute, and deliver a State of California Standard Agreement, and any and all other documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to carry into effect the full intent and purpose of the above resolution, in order to evidence the TOD Grant, the City's obligations related thereto, and the Department's security therefore;
