Special Session of the Legislature to be Conducted Regarding the Current

State Budget Deficit

The Governor has called a special session of the Legislature for Wednesday, November 5 to discuss the current State Budget deficit, which is estimated to be between \$5 billion and \$8 billion. The Governor is expected to push for a sales tax increase, as well as cuts of at least \$2 billion to education spending.

We will continue to monitor the status of the State Budget deficit, as well as any budget proposals that might negatively impact the City.
