Subject: **Transfer of Funds: Traffic Safety Signage**

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the use of the Fourth Council District's one-time infrastructure funds in the Capital Projects Fund (CP) in the Public Works Department (PW) in the amount of \$19,681 to support the installation of Driver Feedback signs at various locations in the Fourth Council District.

DISCUSSION:

With concerns around traffic safety throughout the Fourth Council District additional signage is needed to reduce traffic speeds in specific neighborhood areas including: on 10th Street between Euclid Avenue and Roswell Avenue, on Termino Avenue between 15th Street and Wilton Street; and on Woodruff Avenue near Tevis Avenue.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total project cost of \$19,681 is funded by the Fourth Council District's one-time infrastructure funds in the Capital Projects Fund (CP) in the Public Works Department (PW).
