A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF LONG BEACH PROCLAIMING A DAY OF  
REMEMBRANCE

WHEREAS, the fifth anniversary of the most devastating terrorist attacks  
to ever hit our homeland is upon us; and

WHEREAS, the events of September 11, 2001 resulted in the horrific loss  
of life at the World Trade Center towers, the Pentagon and in a rural field in  
Shanksville, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, public safety personnel responded to the attacks on that  
dreadful day, rescuing thousands of citizens, displaying the honor, commitment and  
sacrifice above and beyond the call of duty; and

WHEREAS, the loss of our dedicated first responders in the collapse of  
the World Trade Center towers following those attacks has burned a place in the public  
consciousness of the date 9/11 and made it a day of remembrance for public safety  
personnel throughout the world;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach hereby  
resolves as follows:

Section 1. That the City of Long Beach proclaims that 9/11 be solemnly  
recognized as a Day of Remembrance for all fire fighters, police officers and other  
public safety personnel who fall in the line of duty, everywhere.

Sec. 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by  
the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify to the vote adopting this resolution.


