AMENDMENT NO. NINE TO CONTRACT NO. 33584

RE: Revision of Contract No. 33584 (ITB-LB14-082) for providing security guard services to the City of Long Beach (BPLB15000038)

This Amendment to Contract No. 33584 is made and entered as of December 11, 2018, by and between the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation, and **GSSI, Inc.** (Contractor)

Contract No. 33584 is amended by mutual agreement of the parties and as indicated below by a check or other mark preceding the appropriate amendment:

- 1. The term is extended to February 15, 2019.
- 2. Adding \$227,250 for a new contract amount of \$1,906,250.
- 3. Prices during this period shall remain firm.
- 4. The price for certain items shall be increased as shown on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
- 5. The price for certain items shall be decreased as shown on Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
- 6. The discount offered to the City is increased by ____ %
- 7. The items or locations identified on Exhibit "B", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, are hereby deleted from the Contract.
- 8. The locations identified on Exhibit "B", which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, are hereby added to the Contract.
- 9. Current permits, licenses, insurance and other required information are attached as Addendum No. 1.

Except as expressly amended above, all terms and conditions in this Contract are ratified and confirmed and remain in full force and effect. Executed with all formalities required by law as of the date first stated above.

Dear Ms. Kol,

I am writing to inform you, in accordance with our contract, that we are providing notice that the minimum wage for the State of California will increase effective January 1, 2019 to \$12.00 per hour. As such our rates will be increasing wages paid to our employees to remain compliant with the terms of our current agreement to pay the minimum wage plus the \$1.75 in Health and Welfare benefit.

The need for this increase is due to the extension of the current contract in anticipation of the upcoming new contract award. The period to be covered will be from January 1, 2019 until February 15, 2019.

The rate increase will be for the \$1.00 increase in minimum wage plus the payroll taxes and insurance burdens. $\$1.00 + \$0.54 = \$1.54$ per hour increase. The Holiday and overtime rate will increase at a 1.5 factor. $\$1.54 \times 1.5 = \2.31 .

I have attached to this letter an updated Exhibit A Fee Schedule for your reference.

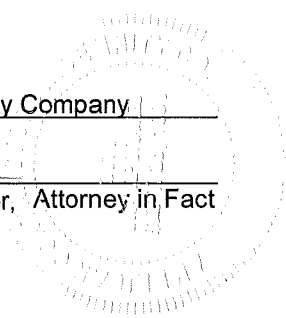

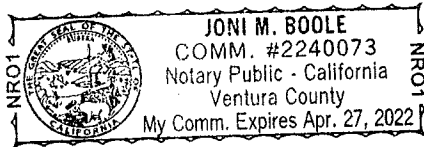
