3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH CONFERRING UPON AND
5 DELEGATING TO THE BOARD OF HARBOR
6 COMMISSIONERS CERTAIN ADDITIONAL POWERS AND
7 DUTIES RELATING TO THE SALE OF PROPERTY AT
8 BROADWAY AND GOLDEN AVENUE, ADJACENT TO THE
9 WORLD TRADE CENTER

10
11 WHEREAS, Section 1204 of the Charter of the City of Long Beach
12 empowers the City Council, by ordinance, to confer upon and delegate to the Board of
13 Harbor Commissioners such additional powers and duties which the City Council deems
14 necessary or convenient to carry out the general purposes of such Board, subject to the
15 approval of such delegation by the Board of Harbor Commissioners; and

16 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach by and through the Board of Harbor
17 Commissioners purchased in 2011 certain property at Broadway and Golden Avenue,
18 adjacent to the World Trade Center, more particularly described on Exhibit A which is
19 attached hereto and incorporated by this reference ("the Property"); and

20 WHEREAS, the Board of Harbor Commissioners now desires to sell the
21 Property; and

22 WHEREAS, the Board of Harbor Commissioners has received several
23 proposals for purchase and development of the Property; and

24 WHEREAS, in order for the Board of Harbor Commissioners to negotiate
25 and execute the necessary documents for the sale of the Property, it is necessary that
26 such authority be conferred upon and delegated to the Board of Harbor Commissioners
27 with respect to the Property.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as

1 follows:

2 Section 1. The City Council of the City of Long Beach, pursuant to Section
3 1204 of the Charter of the City of Long Beach, confers upon and delegates to the Board
4 of Harbor Commissioners the power and duty to negotiate the sale of the Property and to
5 take all actions and enter into any and all agreements necessary to do so.

6 Sec. 2. Pursuant to such conferred and delegated powers, the Board of
7 Harbor Commissioners shall on behalf of the City of Long Beach:

8 (a) Fix and determine the terms and conditions of sale for the
9 Property, consistent with City of Long Beach practices and policies for such sales of real
10 property within the City of Long Beach;

11 (b) Make any findings required by the California Environmental
12 Quality Act regarding the Property; and

13 (c) Take any actions which may be necessary and proper to
14 complete the sale of the Property.

15 Sec. 3. The delegation of powers and duties provided for hereinabove shall
16 become operative on the operative date of a resolution of the Board of Harbor
17 Commissioners approving and accepting the powers and duties so conferred and
18 delegated.

19 Sec. 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance by the
20 City Council and shall cause the same to be posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the
21 City of Long Beach. This ordinance shall take effect on the 31st day after its approval by
22 the Mayor of the City of Long Beach.


