THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO CARES ACT GRANT AGREEMENT NO. 35738 is made and entered into by and between the CITY OF LONG BEACH ("CITY"), a municipal corporation, with its principal place of business at 411 West Ocean Blvd., Long Beach, California 90802, and LONG BEACH NONPROFIT PARTNERSHIP, INC., a nonprofit corporation organized under the laws of the State of California, doing business as THE NONPROFIT PARTNERSHIP ("GRANTEE"), with its principal place of business at 6082 Atlantic Ave., Long Beach, California 90805.

WHEREAS, City and Grantee (the "Parties") entered into Cares Act Grant Agreement No. 35738 whereby City agreed to provide funding to the Grantee to provide support to child care providers for accommodations to meet the COVID-19 guidelines; and

WHEREAS, City and Grantee desire to add additional work to the scope of the work and add additional funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions herein contained, City and Grantee agree as follows:

- 1. An additional One Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$130,000) in grant funds is hereby added to Agreement No. 35738 for a total not to exceed amount of Two Hundred Ninety-Two Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$292,750).
- 2. Exhibit "A" to Agreement No. 35738 is hereby amended and replaced with Exhibit "A-1", attached hereto and incorporated herein.
- 3. Except as expressly amended herein, all terms and conditions in Cares Act Agreement No. 35738 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
