TWENTIETH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 23214

THIS TWENTIETH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 23214 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of September 2, 2008 for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on September 2, 2008, by and between COMPUDYNE PUBLIC SAFETY & JUSTICE, INC., a Virginia corporation, formerly known as TIBURON, INC., a Virginia corporation, ("CompuDyne") and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, the parties entered Agreement No. 23214 whereby Tiburon agreed to provide specialized data processing services to Computer Aided Dispatch ("CAD") and Record Management Systems for City's Police and Fire Departments ("Project") and to grant a license and maintenance for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement has previously been amended to extend the term and add services; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire again to amend the Agreement to add services and software licensing provided by Tiburon relating to an Automatic Vehicle Location and to CAD;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions in Agreement No. 23214 and herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. All references in the Agreement, amendments, attachments and exhibits, to "Tiburon," shall after the execution of this Twentieth Amendment mean, and refer to "CompuDyne."
- 2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Agreement, previous amendments, attachments or exhibits, CompuDyne shall provide the licensing and services described on Exhibit "A" attached to this Twentieth Amendment and incorporated by this reference. City shall pay the fees for the system and services identified on Exhibit "A" in an amount not to exceed \$57,000. City shall pay fifty percent (50%) of the contract price on the execution of this Twentieth Amendment by the City and

EXHIBIT "A"

Description of Services

Tiburon Inc. shall provide an Automatic Vehicle Location ("AVL") software site license to the Long Beach Police Department ("LBPD"), which will allow LBPD to install the client application on an unlimited number of AVL workstations. Tiburon, Inc. shall be responsible for:

- 1. The assignment of one AVL site license to the LBPD.
- 2. The designation of a person to be the principle point of contact for all technical questions relating to the AVL site license installation and use.
- 3. The completion of the (CAD) (AVL) interface project deliverable originally specified in "Task 22 CAD Acceptance" in the original CAD implementation.

Additionally, Tiburon, Inc. shall implement Computer Aided Dispatch logging capability that will receive AVL data input delivered to the CAD Stratus server. The added capability will include the ability to extract and display the log information for selected units and selected periods of time. Tiburon shall also provide facility to play back the information in the log file on a CAD workstation map running in test mode to demonstrate the historical movement of selected AVL units during a selected time period. Tiburon shall demonstrate the ability to select various playback speeds by the system user to provide compressed viewing times. This same playback facility shall allow the reconstruction of a unit's positions at a particular point in time. The amount of AVL log data that is retained in the CAD system shall depend on the amount of dedicated available disk space.

The AVL log data shall be formatted in a manner that will allow loading into a suitable file or database that can be accessed and queried by third party reporting tools for analysis and reporting purposes.

Tiburon shall provide documentation for the use of the log display and playback facility. Tiburon shall also document the configurable time period for determining AVL status "down" in the standard data definition files for CAD tables. All other Historical Redisplay features shall operate automatically and shall not require any additional user guides or reference materials.

Tiburon shall be responsible for:

- 1. Preparation of internal design documents.
- 2. Modifying the application per the "Scope Description."
- 3. Installing the modified code in the client's test environment.
- 4. Providing one (1) four (4) hour on-site training class.
- 5. Correcting any discrepancies in operation, based on the "Scope Description" for post client testing.
- 6. Installing the modified code in the client's production environment.

The City shall pay the fees for the system and services in an amount not to exceed \$57,000. The City shall pay fifty percent (50%) of the contract price on execution of this Twentieth Amendment by the City and the remaining fifty percent (50%) on achievement of the completion criteria, which is defined as placing the Automatic Vehicle Location capability into production use.
