- Established new Bid Line item to construct 6"-Inch thick Portland Cement Concrete Driveway Apron, shown on construction legend, Drawing Sheet 1 of 25, Delta-1 item No. 48, not included on the original contract bid item, at the negotiated unit cost of \$6.67 per square foot (15,446/SF @ \$6.67/SF) as directed by the Project Engineer for the estimated cost of . .
- Credit due to the Agency for the deletion of line item No.52 "PCC Driveway Apron 4" Thick" according to the construction plans this line item will not be used. The estimated contract quantity of 11,500 at \$6.00 per square foot, as directed by the Project Engineer for the lump sum credit cost of. . . .

By signing this change order the Contractor acknowledges that it is familiar with California Civil Code Section 1542, which reads: "A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if known by him must have materially affected his settlement with the debtor;" and Contractor hereby releases the City from any unknown claims and waives its rights under Section 1542.
