3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY
5 MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN
6 THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AND SHARP ELECTRONICS
7 CORPORATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF
8 MAINTENANCE AND SUPPLIES FOR THE MULTI-
9 FUNCTION DEVICES, THROUGH NATIONAL JOINT
10 POWERS ALLIANCE CONTRACTS

12 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach (the "City"), Section
13 1802, permits the City to purchase services, supplies, materials, equipment and labor
14 with other government agencies by purchasing under their contracts on a voluntary and
15 selective basis when authorized by resolution; and

16 WHEREAS, the City desires to contract for maintenance and service of
17 multi-function devices and purchase multi-function supplies and equipment from Sharp
18 Electronics Corporation; and

19 WHEREAS, the National Joint Powers Alliance has a contract for the
20 purchase, maintenance and supplies of multi-function devices under Contract No.
21 101802 for the time period of March 27, 2003 through March 28, 2008 ("NJPA Contract");
22 and

23 WHEREAS, the National Joint Powers Alliance has a contract for the
24 purchase, maintenance and supplies of multi-function devices under Contract No.
25 021808-SP for the time period of March 20, 2008 through March 19, 2012 ("NJPA
26 Contract"); and

27 WHEREAS, the City's participation in the NJPA Contracts will facilitate
28 acquisition of the multi-function devices and supplies as well as provide considerable cost

1 benefits to the City; and

2 WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the
3 NJPA Contracts, considerably more funds would be required; and

4 WHEREAS, the City entered Agreement No. 26089 in 1999 with Sharp
5 Electronics Corporation pursuant to Resolution No. C-27474 to purchase, lease and
6 maintain copiers and purchase copier supplies and equipment; and

7 WHEREAS, the lease rates and term pursuant to Agreement No. 26089 will
8 remain unchanged;

9 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
10 follows:

11 Section 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated
12 herein by this reference.

13 Section 2. The City Manager of the City of Long Beach is hereby
14 authorized to enter an agreement with Sharp Electronics Corporation to lease and
15 maintain multi-function devices and purchase multi-function supplies, in an amount not to
16 exceed \$700,000.00, including tax, as identified in the NJPA Contract.

17 Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
18 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.

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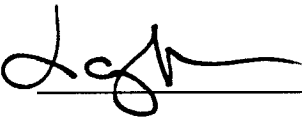
