A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING CERTAIN CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS PERTAINING TO FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO RESPOND TO EMERGENCY DECLARED BY THE STATE GOVERNMENT DUE TO COVID-19

WHEREAS, as a result of the need to proactively slow the spread of, and combat, COVID-19 in the City, the City Public Health Officer issued a Declaration of Local Health Emergency and the Acting City Manager issued a Proclamation of Local Emergency on March 4, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2020, the City Council of the City of Long Beach recognized that an emergency did exist and unanimously passed a Resolution ratifying the City Manager's Proclamation of a Local Emergency and the Public Health Officer's Declaration of Local Health Emergency; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, the Governor of the State of California proclaimed a statewide emergency due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the scope and magnitude of the response necessary to proactively slow the spread of, and combat, COVID-19 in the City is beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach, California, desires to designate and authorize certain City officials to execute documents pertaining to financial assistance for the emergency declared by the Governor of the State of California due to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, to be more responsive and to allow the City of Long Beach to expeditiously apply for, accept, and expend financial assistance to respond to the

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declared emergency due to COVID-19, it is recommended that the City Manager, or designees, be authorized to apply for, accept, and expend financial assistance related to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, all financial assistance accepted under the authority granted by this Council action shall be presented to the City Council at the next practicable opportunity for receive and file; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. That the officials employed in the named positions are hereby authorized to execute for and in behalf of the City of Long Beach, California, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California, applications and other related documents to be filed with any local, state, or federal agency, including, but not limited to, the California Office of Emergency Services and the Federal Emergency Management Agency, for the purpose of obtaining federal, state, or local financial assistance for the emergency due to COVID-19, which was proclaimed by the Governor of the State of California on March 4, 2020, and declared a local and public health emergency by the City Manager and Local Health Officer on March 4, 2020 and ratified by the City Council of Long Beach on March 10, 2020:

financial assistance for the declared emergency due to COVID-19.

by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
