3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING
5 CERTAIN CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS
6 PERTAINING TO FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO RESPOND
7 TO EMERGENCY DECLARED BY THE STATE
8 GOVERNMENT DUE TO COVID-19

10 WHEREAS, as a result of the need to proactively slow the spread of, and
11 combat, COVID-19 in the City, the City Public Health Officer issued a Declaration of
12 Local Health Emergency and the Acting City Manager issued a Proclamation of Local
13 Emergency on March 4, 2020; and

14 WHEREAS, on March 10, 2020, the City Council of the City of Long Beach
15 recognized that an emergency did exist and unanimously passed a Resolution ratifying
16 the City Manager's Proclamation of a Local Emergency and the Public Health Officer's
17 Declaration of Local Health Emergency; and

18 WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, the Governor of the State of California
19 proclaimed a statewide emergency due to COVID-19; and

20 WHEREAS, the scope and magnitude of the response necessary to
21 proactively slow the spread of, and combat, COVID-19 in the City is beyond the control of
22 the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the City; and

23 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach, California, desires
24 to designate and authorize certain City officials to execute documents pertaining to
25 financial assistance for the emergency declared by the Governor of the State of California
26 due to COVID-19; and

27 WHEREAS, to be more responsive and to allow the City of Long Beach to
28 expeditiously apply for, accept, and expend financial assistance to respond to the

1 declared emergency due to COVID-19, it is recommended that the City Manager, or
2 designees, be authorized to apply for, accept, and expend financial assistance related to
3 COVID-19; and

4 WHEREAS, all financial assistance accepted under the authority granted by
5 this Council action shall be presented to the City Council at the next practicable
6 opportunity for receive and file; and

7 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
8 follows:

9 Section 1. That the officials employed in the named positions are hereby
10 authorized to execute for and in behalf of the City of Long Beach, California, a public
11 entity established under the laws of the State of California, applications and other related
12 documents to be filed with any local, state, or federal agency, including, but not limited to,
13 the California Office of Emergency Services and the Federal Emergency Management
14 Agency, for the purpose of obtaining federal, state, or local financial assistance for the
15 emergency due to COVID-19, which was proclaimed by the Governor of the State of
16 California on March 4, 2020, and declared a local and public health emergency by the
17 City Manager and Local Health Officer on March 4, 2020 and ratified by the City Council
18 of Long Beach on March 10, 2020:

10 Section 2. That the City of Long Beach, a public entity established under
11 the laws of the State of California, hereby authorizes the above-designated agents of the
12 City to provide to any federal, state, or local agency the assurances and agreements
13 required for all matters pertaining to COVID-19 related emergency assistance.

14 Section 3. That the officials employed in the positions of City Manager
15 and Assistant City Manager are hereby authorized to execute for and in behalf of the City
16 of Long Beach, California, a public entity established under the laws of the State of
17 California, agreements required to accept financial assistance for the declared
18 emergency due to COVID-19.

19 Section 4. That City Manager, or designee is authorized to expend any
20 financial assistance for the declared emergency due to COVID-19.

21 Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption
22 by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
