## FIFTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 34352

THIS FIFTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT NO. 34352 is made and entered, in duplicate, as of August 5, 2021, for reference purposes only, pursuant to a minute order adopted by the City Council of the City of Long Beach at its meeting on August 3, 2021, by and between UNITED STORM WATER, INC., a California corporation ("Contractor"), with a place of business at 14000 E. Valley Boulevard, City of Industry, California 91746, and the CITY OF LONG BEACH, a municipal corporation ("City").

WHEREAS, City and Contractor (the "Parties") entered into Agreement No. 34352 (the "Agreement") whereby Contractor agreed to provide storm drain routine maintenance and repair; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a First Amendment to the Agreement to add a one-time amount of \$710,000 to cover the many emergency storm calls that took place December 2016 to February 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Second Amendment to the Agreement to extend the term to July 31, 2020 and add the annual agreement amount plus contingency; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Third Amendment to the Agreement to add \$1,269,045 to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Fourth Amendment to the Agreement to extend the term to July 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to add \$1,000,000 to the Agreement for a total not to exceed amount of \$4,704,045, extend the term, and attach an updated rate sheet;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms, covenants, and conditions herein contained, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 1.A. of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:
- "A. Contractor shall furnish specialized services more particularly described in Exhibit "B", attached to the Agreement and incorporated by this

- 2. Section 2 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:
- "2. <u>TERM.</u> The term of this Agreement shall commence at midnight on August 1, 2016, and shall terminate at 11:59 p.m. on April 30, 2022, unless sooner terminated as provided in this Agreement, or unless the services or the Project is completed sooner."
- 3. The Rates in Exhibit "B" to the Agreement are hereby amended in accordance with Exhibit "B-1", attached hereto and incorporated by this reference
- 4. Except as expressly modified herein, all of the terms and conditions contained in Agreement No. 34352 are ratified and confirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
