AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH REPEALING ORDINANCE NO.

C-3377 FOR THE PURPOSE OF REMOVING PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED SPECIAL SETBACK REQUIREMENTS ON THE 5800 BLOCK OF LINDEN AVENUE

The City Council of the City of Long Beach ordains as follows:

Section 1. Upon recommendation of the Planning Commission, it is the determination of the City Council that the public interest and general welfare require the repeal of the following ordinance which established special setbacks in 1954 on private property located on the 5800 block of Linden Avenue in the City of Long Beach.

Henceforth, the setback provisions of the City's Zoning Regulations as set forth in the Long Beach Municipal Code shall apply to such properties. Therefore, the following ordinance is hereby repealed:


