The Economic Development and Finance Committee, on October 19, 2004, approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of Stipulations with Requests for Awards by the City and Ms. Gonzales, based upon a 10 percent permanent disability rating for the injuries of 1/21/02 and 10/22/01, to 5 percent permanent disability for the injury of 10/19/99, to 5 percent permanent disability for the injury of 2/19/01 and to 5 percent permanent disability for the injury of 1/13/98. All agreements would provide for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.

We, therefore, request authority to submit said Stipulations with Requests for Awards for approval by the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board, and if so approved, authority to pay \$10,535.00 in compliance with the Appeals Board Orders.




Mr. McNicholl has made a claim for injuries allegedly sustained in the course of his employment with the City of Long Beach.

The Economic Development and Finance Committee, on October 19, 2004 approved the submission to the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board of Stipulations with Request for Award by the City based upon a 69 percent permanent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary, and a 13 percent permanent disability rating, with provision for lifetime medical care as may be necessary.

We, therefore, request authority to submit said Stipulations with Request for Award for approval by the Workers' Compensation Appeals Board, and if so approved, authority to pay \$71,102.50, and \$5,915.00 in compliance with the Appeals Board order.
