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RESOLUTION NO. RES-21-0094

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE Α CONTRACT PERISCOPE HOLDINGS, INC. ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS AFFORDED TO THE STATE OF TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION RESOURCES (TXDIR), TO PROVIDE **PROCUREMENT TECHNOLOGY** SOLUTION, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$504,282 FOR IMPLEMENTATION, WITH A 20 PERCENT CONTINGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,856, FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$605,138, FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR; AND, AN ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$186,680, WITH A 20 PERCENT CONTINGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$37,336, FOR A TOTAL ANNUAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$224,016, FOR SUBSEQUENT YEARS, UNTIL THE TXDIR CONTRACT EXPIRES ON NOVEMBER 15, 2024

WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Long Beach, Section 1802, permits the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, in writing or otherwise, without advertising for bids, for services, supplies, materials, equipment or labor, with other government agencies, when authorized by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase a procurement technology solution; and

WHEREAS, Periscope Holdings, Inc. has a contract with the state of Texas

Department of Information Resources (TXDIR) for software solutions, including

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commercially available off-the-shelf software products, software as a service, and enterprise resource planning supplemental modules and products, Contract No. CPO-4727 ("TXDIR Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City's participation in the TXDIR Contract will facilitate acquisition of a procurement technology solution as well as provide considerable cost benefits to the City; and

WHEREAS, if the City had to go to formal bid rather than participate in the TXDIR Contract considerably more funds would be required;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to enter a contract with Periscope Holdings, Inc. for a procurement technology solution, in the amount of Five Hundred Four Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Two Dollars (\$504,282) for implementation, with a twenty percent (20%) contingency in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars (\$100,856), for a total amount not to exceed Six Hundred Five Thousand One Hundred Thirty-Eight Dollars (\$605,138), for a period of one (1) year, and, an annual amount of One Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Six Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$186,680), with a twenty percent (20%) contingency in the amount of Thirty-Seven Thousand Three Hundred Thirty-Six Dollars (\$37,336), for a total annual contract amount not to exceed Two Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand Sixteen Dollars (\$224,016), for subsequent years, until the TXDIR contract expires on November 15, 2024, with the option to renew for as long as the TXDIR is in effect, at the discretion of the City Manager.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
