RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Manager to purchase difference in conditions (earthquake insurance), covering City Hall and the Convention Center, for the period of July 1, 2012 through July 1, 2013, through Alliant Insurance Services, Inc., for a total premium not to exceed \$250,000. (Citywide)

DISCUSSION

For many years, the City did not purchase earthquake insurance because of exorbitant pricing. Last year, after lengthy negotiation, the City was able to procure a policy for earthquake insurance for a total premium not to exceed \$250,000. This year, the City has again procured earthquake insurance at a reasonable cost. The total premium of \$250,000 is flat, when compared to last fiscal year. The insurance will grant the City \$7.5 million/occurrence in coverage after the City exhausts a \$5 million self-insured retention, covering both City Hall and the Convention Center, in the event of an earthquake. The annual aggregate of the policy is also \$7.5 million. The insurance will cover the buildings, personal property within the buildings, and actual loss of income because of a building closure.

This matter was reviewed by Deputy City Attorney Amy Webber on May 30, 2012 and Budget Management Officer Victoria Bell on May 31, 2012.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action is requested on June 19, 2012, to allow the City to officially bind insurance coverage.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total premium cost will not exceed \$250,000 for the period of July 1, 2012 through July 1, 2013. Funding has been budgeted in the Insurance Fund (IS 390) within the The cost of difference in conditions Department of Human Resources (HR). (earthquake) insurance is allocated to all funds, with approximately 18 percent allocated to the General Fund. There is no local job impact associated with this request.
