- Provides comprehensive, high quality health care and health promotion to medically underserved, low-income, and high-risk populations of all ages.

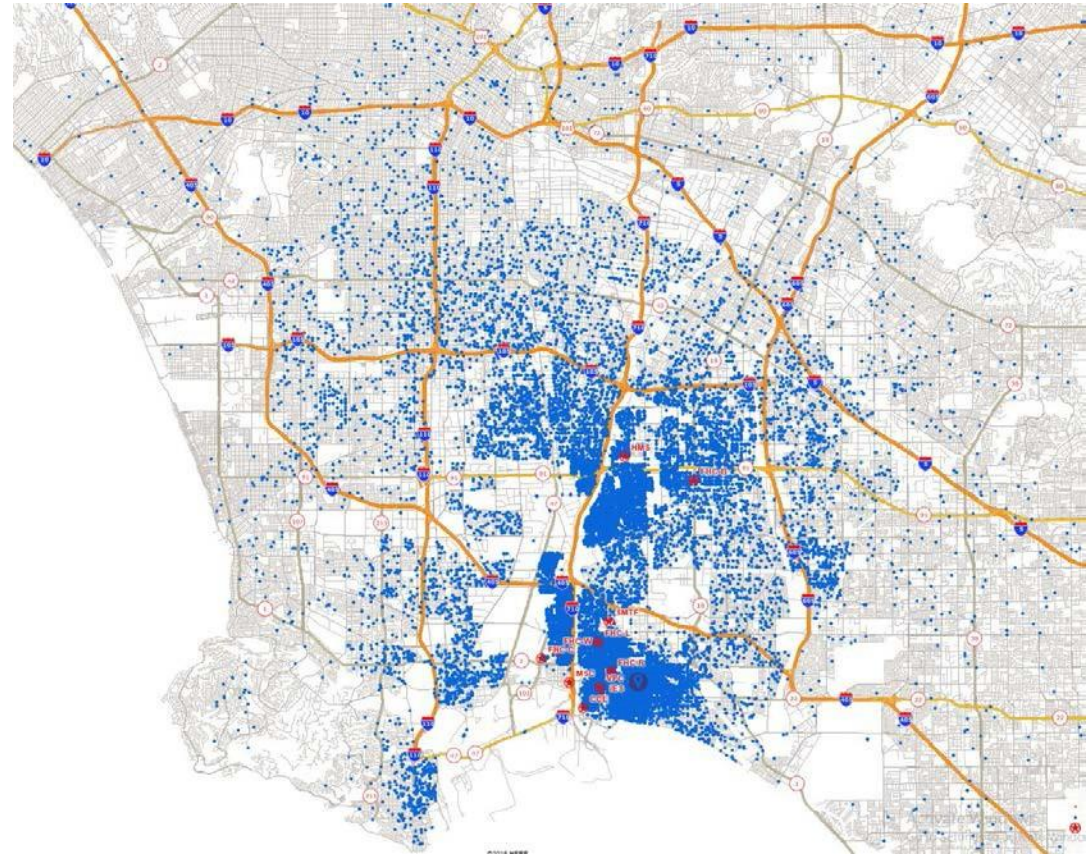
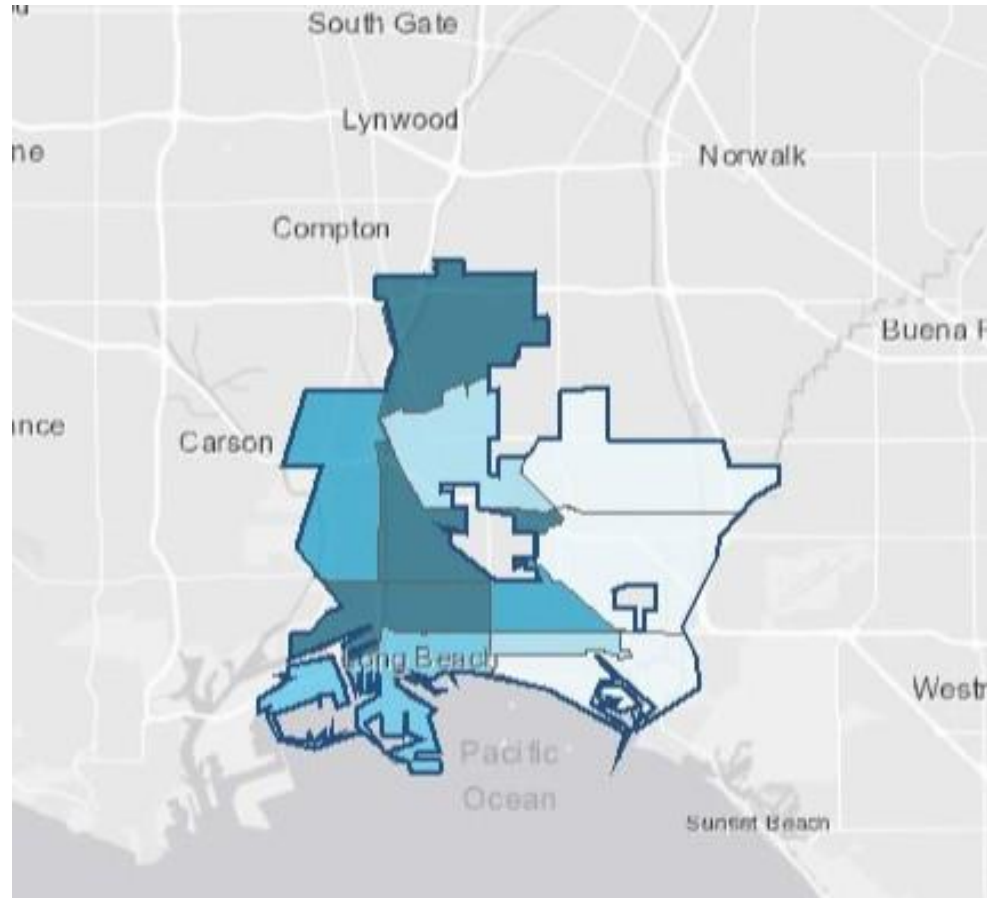

TCC Homeless Services



- **1,894** homeless individuals in Long Beach*
- **1,336** homeless patients served by the entire TCC Family Health system
- **1,110** homeless patients served by TCC at the City of Long Beach's Multi Service Center for the Homeless
- **13% (27 families)** of the **209** high risk newborns referred for TCC's Selective Home Visiting program are homeless
- **6,000** medical and behavioral health visits

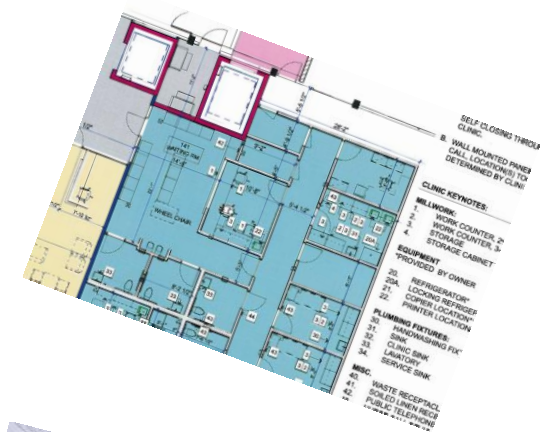

Key Community Benefits

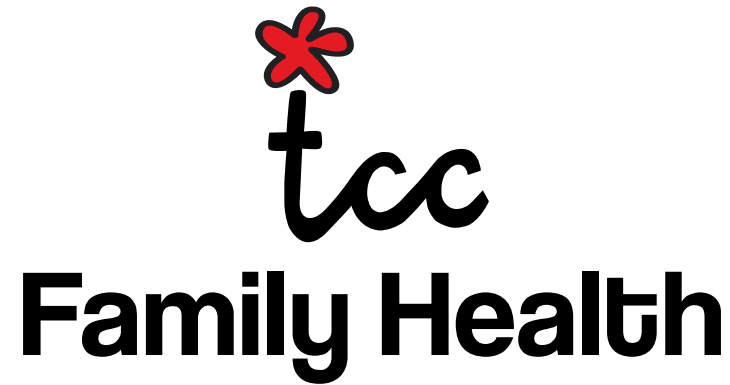
- **Improve** physical and emotional health for patients of all ages in the surrounding community
