SUBJECT: Agreement With the State Department of Health Services to Provide Targeted Case Management Services to Eligible Medi-Cal Beneficiaries (Citywide)

## DISCUSSION

For the past ten years, the City of Long Beach, Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), has been providing Targeted Case Management (TCM) services to eligible Medi-Cal beneficiaries. Under this agreement with the State Department of Health Services (State), DHHS staff assists eligible clients in gaining access to necessary medical, social, educational, and other services. These services are provided by staff in Public Health Nursing, Maternal and Child Health, Communicable Disease, Preventive Health and Human and Social Services programs during the course of their client encounters.

The proposed agreement will allow the DHHS to continue to claim reimbursement for the provision of TCM services. The term of the agreement is July 1, 2004 through June 30, 2007.

This matter was reviewed by Senior Deputy City Attorney Donna Gwin on June 2, 2004 and by Budget Manager Michael Killebrew on June 7, 2004.

## TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

## FISCAL IMPACT

The DHHS will receive reimbursement from the State based on the number of qualified TCM encounters provided to eligible Medi-Cal clients. While the agreement does not specify a dollar amount, annual revenue of \$500,000 is budgeted in the Health Fund (SR 130) and in the Department of Health and Human Services (HE).

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IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL:

Authorize the City Manager to execute all necessary documents with the State Department of Health Services to provide Targeted Case Management Services for a period of three years in an estimated annual amount of \$500,000.
