RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt the attached Resolution to authorize the City Manager to submit a grant application through the State Department of Boating and Waterways, in an amount not to exceed \$400,000, for the replacement of Dock 8 in the Rainbow Marina; and to execute any documents necessary for the implementation and administration of the project at a total cost of approximately \$800,000. (District 2)

DISCUSSION

The Department of Parks, Recreation and Marine (PRM) has identified a grant opportunity for funding of guest docks. The grant program is specifically developed for the installation or replacement of guest docks. Dock 8 in the Rainbow Marina, is used as a guest dock for vessels visiting the Shoreline Village, the Pike at Rainbow Harbor or other downtown establishments. It is currently in a state of disrepair, and needs to be replaced.

The resolution was prepared and the letter was reviewed by Principal Deputy City Attorney Charles Parkin on October 9, 2006, and Budget Management Officer David Wodynski on October 16, 2006.

TIMING CONSIDERATIONS

City Council action is requested on October 24, 2006, as the deadline to submit the application to the Department of Boating and Waterways in Sacramento is October 24, 2006.

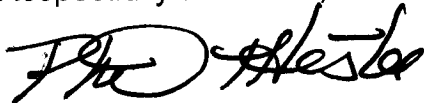
FISCAL IMPACT

The total project is estimated to cost \$800,000. The grant, if awarded, would provide up to 50 percent of the total cost, or \$400,000. There are sufficient funds budgeted in the Tidelands Operating Fund (TF) in the Department of Public Works (PW), Project 8340, to cover the remaining \$400,000. If the grant is awarded, the Department will request City Council authorization to accept and appropriate the funds.

3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4 CITY OF LONG BEACH REQUESTING A GRANT IN THE
5 AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$400,000 FROM THE

7 WATERWAYS FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF DOCK 8 IN

10 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach is desirous of replacing guest Dock 8 in
11 the Rainbow Marina which is in a state of disrepair and in need of replacement; and

12 WHEREAS, the Department of Boating and Waterways is authorized to
13 provide grants to cities, counties, districts, and other public agencies for the installation or
14 replacement of guest docks; and

15 WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach is willing to enter into an agreement to
16 provide for the replacement of Dock 8 in the Rainbow Marina; and

17 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
18 follows:

19 Section 1. The City Council of the City of Long Beach by adoption of this
20 resolution hereby requests that the Department of Boating and Waterways provide a grant
21 in an amount not to exceed \$400,000 for the purpose of replacing Dock 8 in Rainbow
22 Marina which is used as a guest dock for vessels visiting the Shoreline Village, the Pike or
23 other downtown establishments.

24 Sec. 2. The City agrees to accept the grant and hereby authorizes the City
25 Manager to sign the grant agreement and accept the grant for the purpose stated above.

26 Sec. 3. Further, the City recognizes and accepts the 50% match required in
27 the grant.

28 Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the
