Drafting of ordinance provisions that: 1) Maintains the City's determination that billboards in freeway landscape areas are non-conforming billboards; 2) Permits the placement of electronic billboards in freeway landscape areas in exchange for removal of billboard signs in freeway landscape areas via a cap and trade program or a development agreement program (referred to as a "dual track program"); 3) Requires a billboard company development agreement to provide for the removal of at least one non-conforming billboard sign (of equal or greater square footage) that is located in freeway landscape area or in an adjacent area that shows to or is visible from the freeway; 4) Retains the billboard spacing distances set forth in Table in 54-1, specifically 300 feet for poster size billboards and 500 feet for bulletin size billboards; 5) Maintains the establishment of a performance bond; and B. That staff conduct a field survey and analysis to determine the impact of the foregoing provisions in order to ensure that the ordinance introduced for first reading does not provide a competitive advantage to one billboard company to the disadvantage of another.
