## PROJECT: LONG BEACH BLUELINE SIGNAL PRIORITIZATION PROJECT

CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER AUTHORIZATION NO. 1

## PART 1 Reason for Change

- 1.1 Change order required because flood control channel at STA 173+70 caused the proposed 3 inch conduit to be rerouted from the sidewalk (per plan) to the street and back to the sidewalk.
- 1.2 Change order required because existing pull boxes on 1<sup>st</sup> St. between Pine and Long Beach Blvd at the bus stop and on Ocean Blvd and Locust could not be located, the raceways in these pull boxes are to be used for proposed fiber cable.
- 1.3 Change order required because existing conduits that were to be used as fiber optic cable raceways were not able to be utilized in their current condition per plan.
- 1.4 Change order required because Traffic Engineering did not have signal timing prepared in time for new traffic equipment installation. Aldridge installed gear per schedule and was forced to remobilize to complete installation when signal timing became available.
- 1.5 Change order required because additional exploratory excavations were required for utilities omitted or incorrectly reflected in bid set plans.
- 1.6 Change order required because newly purchased 2070 controllers did not have the required D4 or Omni software required for field use.
- 1.7 Change order required because loop detectors at 16<sup>th</sup> and Long Beach Blvd were not operational and the signal was placed on a left turn recall. The left turn recall in the traffic timing would negatively affect D4 program and signal prioritization for the Blueline.

#### **PART 2 Description of Change**

- 2.1 Provide all labor, material and equipment to terminate 3 inch conduit that was installed in the street to replaced pull box in side walk at STA 173+70. Work was performed on Time and Material.
- 2.2 Provide all labor, material and equipment to locate existing pull boxes at Ocean and Locust and on 1<sup>st</sup> between Long Beach Blvd. and Pine at bus station. Verify raceways and prepare conduits for fiber optic cables. Work was performed on Time and Material.
- 2.3 Provide all labor, material and equipment to verify an alternative fiber path or clean out plugged raceways and prepare conduits for proposed fiber at 3<sup>rd</sup>/Pacific, 4<sup>th</sup>/Pacific, 5<sup>th</sup>/Pacific and 12<sup>th</sup>/Long Beach Blvd. Work to be performed on Time and Material.
- 2.4 Provide all labor, material and equipment for remobilization at Pacific and Wardlow, to complete contract signal upgrade work with new signal timing. Work to be performed on Time and Material.
- 2.5 Provide all labor, material and equipment to perform additional exploratory excavations for unaccounted. Work was done at a negotiated price.
- 2.6 Provide all labor, material and equipment to install D4 software for 8 ea 2070 controllers and Omni software for 21 ea 2070 controllers.

2.7 Provide all labor, material and equipment to install 8 ea north bound loop detectors at 16<sup>th</sup> and Long Beach Blvd to optimize Blueline signal prioritization. Existing loops were not operating and northbound left turn was on phase recall. Work was done at an agreed upon price.

5.	Provide all labor, material and equipment to perform additional exploratory excavations throughout areas that required new conduit to locate existing utilities which were not reflected on bid set plans.  All work as directed by the Project Manager, for the lump sum cost of
6.	Provide all labor, material and equipment to install D4 software on 8 ea 2070 controllers and Omni software on 21 ea 2070 controllers.  All work as directed by the Project Manager, for the lump sum cost of
7.	Provide all labor, material and equipment to install 8 ea northbound vehicle loop detectors at Long Beach and 16 <sup>th</sup> .  All work as directed by the Project Manager, for the lump sum cost of
