

- there is a warrant for the person's arrest



ATTACHMENT A

YOU ARE THEREFORE COMMANDED TO SEARCH:

2412 Hannum Drive, in the City of Corona, County of Riverside; including all rooms, attics, basements, garages, outdoor utility rooms, mailboxes, and other containers and parts therein. The residence is two story single family residence. The exterior consists of brown stucco and brown trim. The numbers "2412" are posted on the east side of the house and are visible from the street.

19009 Laurel Park Road, Space 48, in the City of Rancho Dominguez, County of Los Angeles; including all rooms, attics, basements, garages, outdoor utility rooms, mailboxes, and other containers and parts therein. The residence is located within a mobile home park called, Dominguez Hills. The mobile home is red in color with grey trim. The front door faces west. It is the third mobile home east of the mobile home park's west perimeter on the south end. Space 48 is located between space 47 and space 49.

The person of **Christopher Keane Woodard** described as a black male with brown hair, green eyes, approximately 6'01" tall, 235 lbs in weight, and born on November 22, 1973. His ANI / CDL is B4106245.

The person of **Demetric Ramon Woodard** described as a black male with black hair, brown eyes, approximately 5'06" tall, 180 lbs in weight, and born on May 19, 1975. His ANI / CDL is A9651940.

Also to be searched are all vehicles registered to, used by, under the control of, or found at the listed locations that are connected to any of the individuals involved in these criminal acts or conspiracies including and not limited to a 2001 Nissan with CA license plate 5KLY631, a 2005 Chevrolet with CA license plate FRKVAN, a 2004 Kawasaki motorcycle with CA license plate 20D9457, a white 2008 four door Dodge with CA license plate 6DAZ085, a 2008 four door Cadillac with CA license plate 6UVM650, a dark blue 2012 Ford Edge with CA license plate 6URA866, and a gold Hyundai Sonata.

ATTACHMENT B

FOR THE FOLLOWING PROPERTY / PERSON:

Marijuana and paraphernalia commonly associated with the cultivation, storage, sale and use of Marijuana, consisting in part of and including, but not limited to pipes, sifters, alligator clips, baggies, scales and other weighing devices, and books, posters, or diagrams depicting or instructing on the cultivation of marijuana; together with other articles and instrumentalities utilized in connection therewith; and articles of personal property tending to establish the identity of persons in control of premises, vehicles, storage areas or containers where controlled substances may be found, consisting in part of and including, but not limited to, utility company receipts, rent receipts, canceled mail envelopes and keys.

Marijuana, paraphernalia associated with its ingestion, sales, transportation and cultivation: pipes, cigarette rolling papers, sifters, alligator clips, bong, plastic bags, film canisters, scales and other measuring devices, marijuana seeds, grow lights, potting soil, containers for planting, chemicals and fertilizers, pruning and gardening tools, buyer lists, seller lists, recordation of sales, books and pamphlets containing instructions on cultivation, personal telephone books, address books, telephone bills, papers and documents containing lists of names, addresses, phone numbers, utility company receipts, rent receipts, addressed envelopes, keys, and photographs.

Marijuana or any parts thereof (such as living plants and dried processed mater) including hash and paraphernalia commonly associated with the cultivation, storage, sales, and use of marijuana (such as pipes, alligator clips, baggies, scales, and other weighing devices), lights, hoses, and other paraphernalia used for growing marijuana, books, paper recording devices, pay-owe sheets, buyers lists, ledgers, and other items that can be used to record sale transactions.

Items used to grow marijuana indoors, grow lights, metal halide lamps, high pressure sodium lamps, high intensity discharge lighting ballasts, circulating fans, exhaust fans, light canopies, carbon filters, Ph and nutrient level testing kits, electrical timers, light rails, circular light movers, hydroponic containers, grow mediums, CO2 injection systems, fertilizers, rock wool, gardening pots, reflective surfaces, timers, thermometers, hygrometers, and other miscellaneous items used to grow marijuana.

United States and foreign currency, safes, financial instruments, bank statements, bank account numbers, financial institution statements, financial institution account numbers, state and federal income tax returns, and related records tied to or in the possession of each of the suspect(s) and / or co-conspirators.

Computers and computer systems, including computer records, whether on paper or stored on magnetic media including information contained within a computer or computer system; including computer hardware, software, and data, including central processing units, hard disks, hard disk drives, tape drives, CD-ROM drives, display

screens, keyboards, printers, modems, magnetic tapes, zip drives, zip drive disks, files and documents in the form of optical media, electronic media, computer manuals and resource books, computer cables and connections, pieces of paper with computer passwords, computer networks addresses and codes, cassette tapes, floppy disks, and cash registers, found together or separately from one another. Any device capable of gathering or storing information and any type of video recording devices.

Any records, whether stored on paper, on magnetic media such as tape, cassette, disk, diskette or on memory storage devices such as optical disks, thumb drives, programmable instruments such as telephones, "electronic calendar / address books," calculators, or any other media, together with records of use, ownership, possession, or control of such records.

Any written or computer communication in printed or stored medium such as E-mail and Chat logs, whether in active files, deleted files or unallocated spaces on the hard drive, floppy drive or any data storage media.

Search of all the above items is for files, data, images, software, operating systems, deleted files, altered files, system configurations, drive and disk configurations, date and time, and unallocated and slack space, for evidence.

Articles of personal property tending to establish the identity of persons in control of the premises, vehicles, storage areas and containers being searched to include utility company receipts, rent receipts, addressed mail, keys, and personal identification to include wallets, purses, and carrying cases that bear and contain a person's name, driver's license, credit cards, birth certificates, social security cards, and tax returns.

Documents, tickets, itinerary notes, receipts, reservations, confirmations, maps, and other items related to domestic and international travel. Books, records, invoices, receipts, records of real estate, securities transactions, bank statements, bank account numbers, financial institution statements, financial institution accounts, and related records, passbooks, moneydrafts, letter of credit, money orders, bank drafts, cashier's checks, checkbooks, tax returns, loan statements, work papers, escrow files, Form 1099 and wire transfer records evidencing the obtaining, secreting, transfer and / or concealment of assets and the obtaining, secreting, transfer, concealment and / or expenditure of narcotics proceeds in violation of money laundering statutes.

Personal calendars, address and / or telephone books, rolodex indices and papers reflecting names, addresses, telephone numbers, pager numbers, fax numbers and / or telex numbers, correspondence of the subject(s) of the investigation and their criminal associates, sources of supply, customers, financial institutions and other individuals or businesses with whom a financial relationship exists.

Communication devices, such as: cellular telephones, other telephones, radios, fax machines, telephone answering devices or machines and/or any recording tapes located therein. Searching officers are directed to answer, record, monitor, note and converse

with callers who appear to be calling in regards to controlled substance crimes or other criminal activity, on any telephone or cellular phone with the location(s) to be searched, without revealing the officers identities.

Officers are directed to search cellular phones for any stored content including and not limited to digital images, photographs, incoming and outgoing SMS and MMS messages, contacts, and phone call logs.

Officers may also access any telephone numbers or messages stored within the memory of any cellular phone located during the search, for the purpose of calling or identifying co-conspirators. In addition, officers are directed to seize, note, and record phone numbers and other messages within and received on any cellular phone, telephonic beeper, digital beeper, or pager within the location(s) to be searched for the purposes of calling or identifying those persons paging the suspects to determine if the page was regarding an intended controlled substance transaction, without revealing the officers identities.

Other controlled substances, such as heroin, methamphetamine, cocaine, GHB, hallucinogens, illegally possessed pharmaceutical drugs, or any analogs of scheduled controlled substances.

All types of surveillance or monitoring equipment and detection devices used to provide warning.

STATEMENT OF EXPERTISE

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Your affiant, Detective David Strohmman, is employed by the Long Beach Police Department and has been a Police Officer for the past 18 years. Your Affiant is currently assigned to the Narcotics Investigations Section. It is your affiant's primary responsibility to investigate suspect(s) involved in the distribution of narcotics in the City of Long Beach. Your affiant has received formal training in the field of narcotics investigations at the basic Police Academy course at the Long Beach Police Department. The training consisted of identification, under the influence, possession, possession for sale, and packaging of various narcotics. Your affiant has attended advanced officer training at the Long Beach Police Department on the structure of sales of marijuana, cocaine, heroin, methamphetamine and other contraband in the County of Los Angeles. In addition, your affiant works with other narcotic experts with whom your affiant has discussed the aspects of sales, packaging, manufacturing, and use of narcotics by traffickers in the Los Angeles County area.

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During my past assignments, I have developed experience in the daily operation of drug traffickers through personal observations and personal contacts with drug buyers, users, and sellers. In my regular course of duty, I have conducted numerous surveillances where I have observed subjects sell, purchase, use, and conceal narcotics. I have spoken with hundreds of users and dealers of narcotics about the common methods of sales, packaging, usage, and concealment of narcotics. I have participated in over 400 investigations and/or arrests of persons involved in the sale, possession for sale, possession of controlled substances, and persons under the influence of controlled substances. During four years as a Vice Detective I personally purchased various narcotics over 100 times while working in an undercover capacity.





NARRATIVE

1 Your affiant conducted a narcotics investigation at 2200 Lakewood Boulevard #A in the
2 City of Long Beach. This location is a Medical Marijuana Dispensary (**Industry Green**) that is
3 operating illegally within the City of Long Beach in violation of Long Beach Municipal Code
4 5.89.030 (B). On the Internet this location is described as a Medical Marijuana Collective. On
5 the Internet I found a website for the "Industry Green Collective" that listed quantities of
6 Marijuana along with their respective cost. On this website it stated, "Starting Friday extended
7 hours!!!! 10AM-Midnight...All 1/8ths capped at \$40.....2 Grams For \$25 all strains
8 everyday...We split 1/8th and OZ.....Capped at \$320 everyday....Free gift for first time
9 patients...Come try the planets.....Home of the \$40..."

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12 Therefore, during the period of April 13th, 2012 and April 26th, 2012 I enlisted the aid of
13 a Reliable Confidential Informant (RCI) for the purpose of attempting to make a controlled buy of
14 narcotics from this location. This RCI has worked with me on several investigations and has
15 always been found to be reliable. Prior to conducting this investigation I searched the RCI and
16 found the RCI to be void of any contraband. I provided the RCI with an amount of U.S.
17 currency. The RCI, under my direction, went to 2200 Lakewood Boulevard #A and entered the
18 location.

19 The RCI eventually contacted a female White employee standing behind a glass display
20 case, which displayed several jars of Marijuana. This suspect identified herself as Jessica.
21 During conversation S-Jessica identified a price board hanging on the wall and she identified
22 quantities of Marijuana and their cost. The RCI inquired about having to volunteer at the location
23 because he was now a member of the collective. S-Jessica stated, "We don't force anyone to
24 do volunteer work" she continued talking and stated, "We don't charge you taxes, the price you
25 see is the price you get."

1 The RCI requested to buy \$20 dollars worth of Marijuana and S-Jessica agreed. The RCI
2 then observed S-Jessica weigh and package an amount of Marijuana. The RCI inquired about
3 getting a job at the location and about how much S-Jessica was paid for working at the location.
4 S-Jessica eventually stated she was paid "Minimum wage" for working at the location. At the
5 conclusion of the conversation the RCI exchanged the city funds with S-Jessica for an amount of
6 Marijuana. After the exchange the RCI returned to me and gave me the substance he/she had
7 just purchased. Based on my training and experience I believed this substance to be Marijuana.

8 Based on the above investigation I believe this location (Industry Green), although
9 operating as a Medical Marijuana Collective, is selling Marijuana for a profit in violation of state
10 law.

11 Therefore, based on my training and experience, as well as the above articulated
12 observations and information in this affidavit, that the location listed on page 2, is currently being
13 utilized to store or traffic narcotics. I believe that when this warrant is executed at the location I
14 will find evidence of controlled substance distribution. Therefore, I pray a search warrant be
15 issued for this address, for the suspect, and for the vehicles at the location.

LONG BEACH POLICE DEPARTMENT**Narrative**

Item #503 - Receipts - Numerous receipts documenting Marijuana transactions. Recovered from several boxes on floor of office. Secured in narcotics office pending follow up investigation.

It should be noted that Det. Destefano recovered my \$40 dollars of prerecorded city funds on the counter next to the cash register. The money was photocopied and returned to me for future investigations.

In the back office we located a large safe that we were initially unable to access. Also in this room Det. Kirk located a rent bill (**Item #407**) that was addressed to Demetric Woodard and Christopher Woodard at 2200 Lakewood Blvd #A in the City of Long Beach. There was a note on the safe to call Chris at 310-251-2538 if there were any problems regarding the safe. The Chris listed on the note I believed was Chris Woodard M/B/10-22-73. From previous investigations I learned that Chris Woodard and Demetric Woodard M/B/5-19-75 were the possible owners of the Industry Green Collective/Dispensary. I called Chris and informed him we served a search warrant at his business and requested him to come open the safe. He refused to come down so a locksmith was requested.

Officer Kirk and Sgt. Long remained at the location awaiting the locksmith while I went to the station to prepare my police reports. Just prior to leaving Demetric Woodard arrived on scene and identified himself as the brother of Christopher Woodard. During conversation I asked what involvement Demetric Woodard had with the business. He tried to downplay his involvement by saying he was just the brother of the owner. I asked if he had a key to the location and he stated he did. I asked him how often he came by the location and he stated, "I come by from time to time and take care of things." Based on the rent bill addressed to him at the business, his statement and the fact he had a key to the location it was apparent he was involved in the operation of the business. At this time I advised him he was under arrest and he was transported to the police station.

I then went to the station and Mirandized Demetric Woodard per P.D. 1000.008 to which he stated, "Yes" he understood his rights. During questioning he stated he had no business ties to the business other than being the owner's brother. When asked why he had a key to the location he stated he lived near by and could respond if there were any emergencies. I then asked why his name was on the rent bill along with his brother's name. He informed me he was involved in real estate so he helped located the property. I still inquired why his name would be on the rent bill and he told me because he has better credit. That concluded my interview and he was released to jail personnel.

I then went to my office to prepare reports. While in my office Christopher Woodard called me and requested information about the charges his employees were arrested for. While speaking with Mr. Woodard I asked if he and his brother were the owners of the Industry Green Collective. Although he would not use the word owner he did state he was the "Managing Patient." He further advised me his brother was not involved with the business in any way. At the conclusion of the conversation Mr. Woodard advised me he would attempt to have someone go to the business and open the safe. Officer Kirk later advised me a female Black arrived and identified herself as Kendall Woodard F/B/8-7-64 and she was the sister of Christopher Woodard. She opened the safe then left the scene.

Once the safe was open Officer Kirk recovered and placed into evidence the following items.

Item #402 - Marijuana - Large duffel bag containing 34 plastic bags of Marijuana. The Marijuana was placed into brown paper bags prior to putting it into evidence.

Item #403 - Misc. paperwork.

Item #404 - Electronic cash register. Recovered from southeast room.

Item #405 - U.S. Currency - Undetermined amount of U.S. currency recovered from safe and seized per 11470 HS.

Item #406 - Key to front door recovered from Deft. Woodard by Det. Strohmman.

A copy of my search warrant was left inside of the business. Due to the fact officers were unable to properly secure the front door they requested public service and had the location boarded up and secured.
