REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY BOARD MEMBERS City of Long Beach California

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve and authorize the Executive Director to enter into agreements with LPA, Inc., and Urban Arena for urban architectural design services; with Field Paoli Architects for urban planning services; and with Jon D. Cicchetti Landscape Architects, Mia Lehrer & Associates, and Troller Mayer Associates, Inc., for landscape architectural services. (All Project Areas – Citywide)

DISCUSSION

The Redevelopment Agency (Agency) frequently uses the tools of urban design, urban planning and landscape architecture to better facilitate efforts to shape the City of Long Beach for the future. For this purpose, Agency staff administered a Request for Proposals (released on September 12, 2008) seeking qualified firms. Fourteen firms submitted qualifications and six of these firms were selected based on their extensive experience working with public agencies in their respective field.

Agency staff proposes to enter into the following agreements:
