The Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) received the above application on February 29, 2012. The applicant applied for a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) with the City on February 22, 2012. City Council response is due to ABC by March 30, 2012; however, the request for a CUP will not be heard by the Planning Commission until approximately May 2012. Provided the CUP is approved by the Planning Commission and is not appealed within the required 10-day appeal period, the recommendation includes a request to direct the City Manager to withdraw the Public Notice of Protest.
