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3	A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
4	CITY OF LONG BEACH ESTABLISHING A REVISED LIST
5	OF CITY COUNCIL STANDING COMMITTEES, AND
6	COUNCIL AUTHORITIES AND SPECIAL COMMITTEES
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8	WHEREAS, Section 2.03.060 of the Long Beach Municipal Code permits
9	the City Council to establish committees by resolution; and
10	WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Long Beach has traditionally
11	adopted a new list of City Council Standing Committees, Authorities and Memberships bi-
12	annually; and
13	WHEREAS, on January 12, 2021, the City Council approved a new list of
14	City Council Standing Committees, for a total of nine (9) Standing Committees; renamed
15	"Council Authorities" to "Council Authorities and Special Committees"; and moved three
16	(3) existing standing committees to Council Authorities and Special Committees; and
17	WHEREAS, to promote equity, efficiency, and inclusion, the City Council
18	now desires to resolve to enact these changes to the City Council Standing Committees,
19	Authorities and Memberships;
20	NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Long Beach resolves as
21	follows:
22	Section 1. The City Council hereby re-establishes the Budget Oversight
23	Committee, which will explore public policy positions and provide feedback and ideas to
24	the City Council for the purposes of developing budget for the upcoming fiscal year,
25	which will be presented to the full City Council for consideration.
26	Section 2. The City Council hereby re-establishes the Economic
27	Development and Finance Committee, which will explore public policy positions and
28	provide feedback and ideas to the City Council with respect to strengthening the City's
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OFFICE OF THE CITY ATTORNEY CHARLES PARKIN, City Attorney 411 W. Ocean Boulevard, 9th Floor Lona Beach. CA 90802 tax base, and opportunities to issue bonds, revenues and financing, to encourage
 economic development in Long Beach.

Section 3. The City Council hereby re-establishes the Federal Legislation
Committee, which will provide policy direction annually for City Council consideration with
respect to the upcoming year's federal legislative agenda, and will review the City's
progress on legislative positions adopted by the City Council.

Section 4. The City Council hereby re-establishes the State Legislation
Committee, which will provide policy direction annually for City Council consideration with
respect to the upcoming year's state legislative agenda, and will review the City's
progress on legislative positions adopted by the City Council.

Section 5. The City Council hereby re-establishes the Public Safety Committee, which will explore public policy positions for City Council consideration with respect to public safety matters.

14 Section 6. The City Council hereby establishes the Port, Transportation 15 and Infrastructure Committee, which will provide input for City Council consideration into 16 policies impacting operations and projects located in all of the City Tidelands Areas 17 including, subject to the limitations of the Long Beach City Charter, presentations and 18 information from the Port of Long Beach, and will review the City's Capital Improvement 19 Plan (CIP), major street and road improvements, and other large infrastructure projects. 20 Section 7. The City Council hereby establishes the Climate Action and

Environmental Committee, which will explore public policy positions for City Council
consideration with respect to climate change adaptation and matters impacting the
environment.

Section 8. The City Council hereby establishes the Public Health and
Housing Committee, which will explore public policy positions for City Council
consideration with respect to public health, housing and homelessness.

27 Section 9. The City Council hereby establishes the Government,
28 Personnel and Elections Oversight Committee, which will provide policy input and review

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1 for City Council consideration on key City matters, including recommending the naming of 2 City buildings and infrastructure, reviewing smaller litigation settlements, and City Charter 3 Committee appointments. Section 10. The above-referenced nine (9) Standing Committees shall 4 5 operate as follows: 6 Α. Each member of the City Council shall chair a committee, 7 serve as vice chair of a second committee, and be a member of a third committee. With 8 this format, each City Councilmember shall have membership on three Standing 9 Committees. 10 Β. Each Standing Committee shall be subject to the 11 requirements of California Government Code Section 54950 et seg., commonly known as 12 the "Brown Act". C. 13 Each Standing Committee shall be assisted by Staff members 14 in preparing background information, agendas, distributing materials and performing 15 other support functions as needed. 16 Section 11. The City Council hereby renames "Council Authorities" to 17 "Council Authorities and Special Committees", and transfers the following existing 18 standing committees to Council Authorities and Special Committees: 19 Α. Charter Amendment Committee: 20 Β. LBUSD Joint Use Committee; and 21 C. I-710 Oversight Committee. 22 Section 12.
