RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH APPROVING THE APPLICATION
FOR GRANT FUNDS FOR THE URBAN GREENING
GRANT PROGRAM, UNDER THE STRATEGIC GROWTH
COUNCIL FOR THE LONG BEACH LOW IMPACT
DEVELOPMENT ACADEMY

WHEREAS, the Legislature and Governor of the State of California have
provided funds for the program shown above; and

WHEREAS, the Strategic Growth Council has been delegated the
responsibility for the administration of this grant program; establishing necessary
procedures; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by the Strategic Growth Council
require a resolution certifying the approval of Application(s) by the Applicants' governing
board before submission of said Application(s) to the State; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant, if selected, will enter into an Agreement with the
State of California to carry out the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Long Beach City Council
hereby:

Section 1. Approves the filing of an Application for the Long Beach Low
Impact Development Academy; and

Section 2. Certifies that Applicant understands the assurances and
certification in the Application; and

Section 3. Certifies that Applicant or the title holder will have sufficient
funds to operate and maintain the Project(s) consistent with the land tenure requirements;
or will secure the resources to do so; and

1 Section 4. Certifies that it will comply with all provisions of Section 1771.8
2 of the California Labor Code regarding payment of prevailing wages on Projects awarded
3 Proposition 84 Funds; and

4 Section 5. If applicable, certifies that the Project will comply with any laws
5 and regulations including, but not limited to, the California Environmental Quality Act
6 (CEQA), legal requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, disabled access
7 laws, and that prior to commencement of construction, all applicable permits will have
8 been obtained; and

9 Section 6. Certifies that applicant will work towards the Governor's State
10 Planning Priorities intended to promote equity, strengthen the economy, protect the
11 environment, and promote public health and safety as included in Government Code
12 Section 65041.1; and

13 Section 7. Appoints the City Manager, or designee, as agent to conduct all
14 negotiations, execute and submit all documents including, but not limited to Applications,
15 Agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of
16 the aforementioned project(s).

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
Section 8. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
