RECOMMENDATION:

Determine that the application serves the public convenience and necessity, and receive and file the application of Phik Cheng Lin, dba PCH Market, for an Original Alcoholic Beverage Control license, at 1821 Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue, with conditions. (District 6)

DISCUSSION

It is City Council policy to review applications for Alcoholic Beverage Control licenses to determine if a basis for protest against the issuance of the license exists. The attached application lists the possible bases for protest. A Conditional Use Permit (CUP) for the sale of beer and wine for off-site consumption (Type 20 license), with the conditions proposed by the Planning Commission, was approved by the City Council on August 7, 2012.
