WHEREAS, many of these local leaders are recognized at Equality Plaza located at Harvey Milk Promenade Park; and

WHEREAS, the City continues to lead the way in protecting and supporting its LGBTQ community through a multitude of LGBTQ organizations; and

WHEREAS, additionally, every year the City celebrates Long Beach Pride, hosted by Long Beach Lesbian and Gay Pride, Inc. on the third weekend of May; and

WHEREAS, now in its 34th year, this celebration has become the second largest event in the City, attracting nearly 100,000 people a year; and

WHEREAS, it has also become the third largest pride celebration in the nation, ensuring that Long Beach's progressive reach extend throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, the work and advocacy of the LGBTQ community deserves this official recognition by the City of Long Beach;
