Neighborhood Electric Vehicles

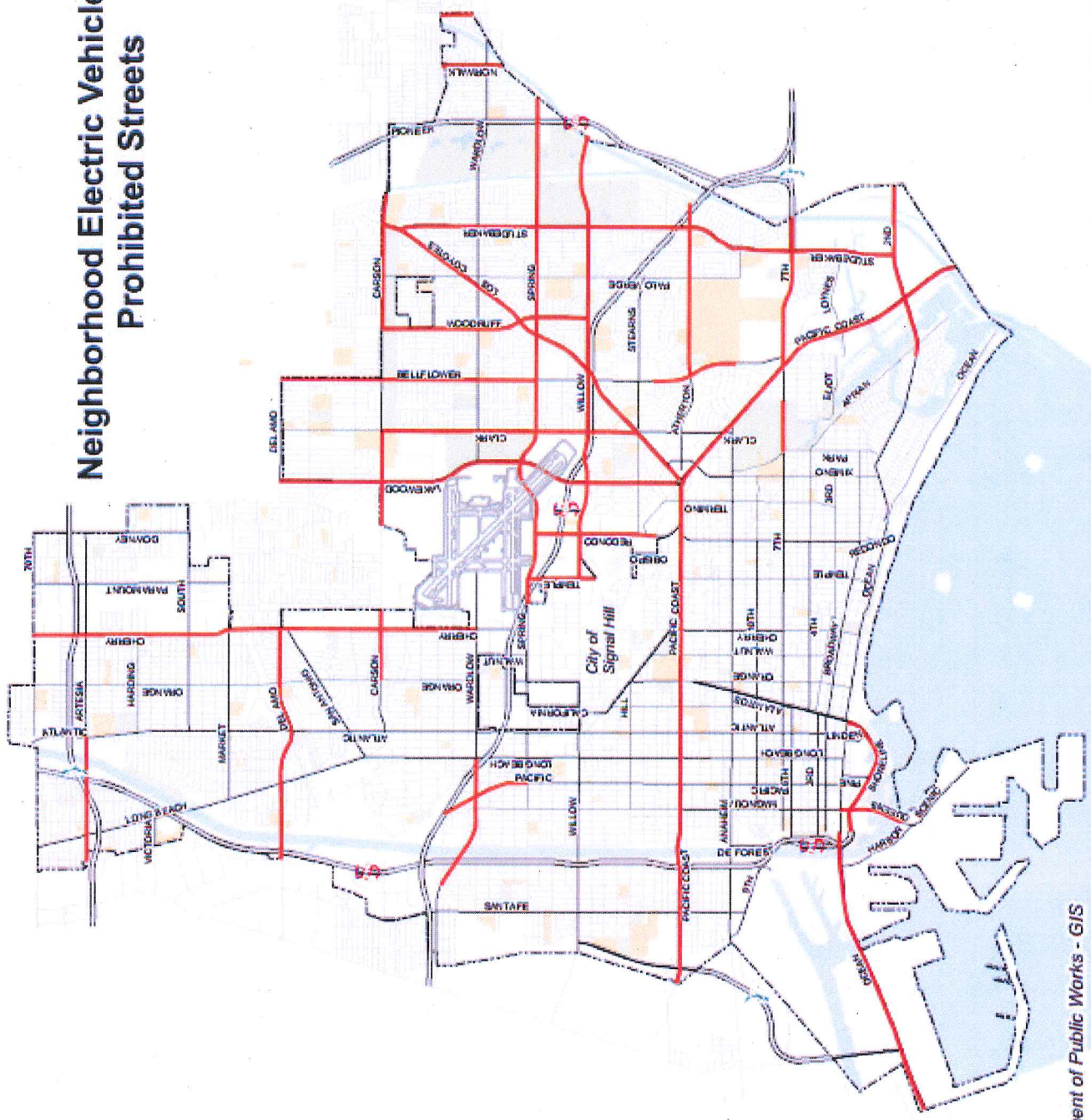
California Vehicle Code Says:

“A Low-Speed vehicle [or NEV] is subject to all the provisions applicable to a motor vehicle”

Except:

- NEVs receive a special exemption in crash-safety standards because they travel no faster than 25mph.
- They must not be driven on roads with a speed limit higher than 35mph

Neighborhood Electric Vehicle (NEV) Prohibited Streets





Neighborhood Electric Vehicles

California Vehicle Code Requires that
Neighborhood Electric Vehicles have:

- The capability to travel at least 20mph
- Registration
- A license plate
- A licensed driver

Golf Carts are NOT Neighborhood Electric Vehicles





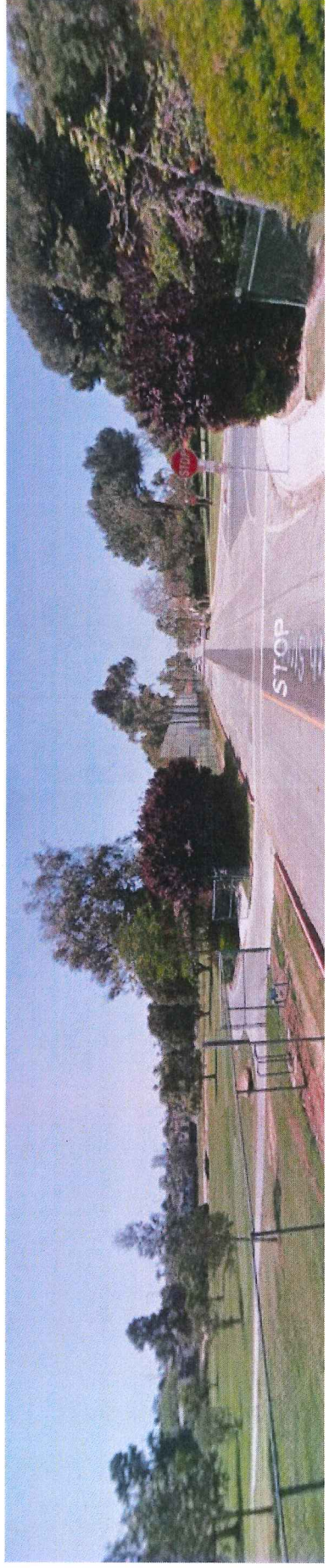
